The Opportunity:

Based at Goliath Gold Complex office near Dryden, ON, we currently have an exciting opportunity for two Geology Co-op Students to join our NexGold team, reporting to the Lead Geologist or designate.

The Geology Co-op Student will support the Geology Team with exploration programs. The Geology Co-op Student should expect significant fieldwork including mapping and prospecting in the role. Data collection and management will be an important part of daily tasks. The role will also support any diamond drilling programs through geoteching, logging, sampling, measuring and core photography.

Key Responsibilities:

- Field mapping and prospecting;
- Following planned traverses;
- Using logging software to capture geological data from outcrops;
- Assisting in the core shack;
- Supporting data compilation, analysis and QAQC in office;
- Working and communicating within the team towards well-defined objectives;
- Working with site operational team to ensure environmental performance meets or exceeds protocols;
- Demonstrating a personal commitment to Safety, Health, and Environment responsibilities; and
- Additional responsibilities or tasks as reasonable assigned.

What You Bring:

Must-Haves

- Enrolled in a co-op program from a recognized college or university in Canada;
- Currently taking a degree or diploma in an applicable geology or related field;
- Has appropriate knowledge of the principles and practices of geology;
- Physically fit for walking several kilometers per day;
- Able to work in adverse weather conditions and terrain;
- Effective communication, interpersonal and organizational skills;
- Ability to work well within a team;
- Strong time management skills with the ability to meet multiple and competing deadlines;

- Skill using, or ability to learn, industry-standard software packages (ie. MxDeposit, Leapfrog or QGIS); and
- Valid driver's license equivalent to G2 or higher in Ontario; and
- Meets the eligibility criteria for grant program funding:
 - Canadian citizen, Permanent Resident of Canada, or Protected Person under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act; *and*
 - Legally entitled to work in Canada and according to relevant Ontario legislation and regulations.

Ideally

- Students in the 3rd year of their program or above with some field mapping courses completed;
- Previous geological work as a summer student;
- Experience in a mining or industrial environment;
- Familiarity using a GPS, compass, and maps;
- Proficient in the use of Microsoft Office Suite (i.e., Word, Excel, PowerPoint, Outlook, Teams); and
- Students who have a student membership in a professional geological association.
